TIPS FOR SAFE DIGGING



1

NOTIFY

Call 8-1-1 or make a request online by visiting: www.ndonecall.com. Be sure to make the request two to three days before you start.

2

WAIT

Wait three days for a response to your request. Affected utilities will send a locator to mark any underground utility lines.



3

CONFIRM

Confirm that all affected utilities have responded by comparing the markers to the list of utilities the 8-1-1 call center notified



4

RESPECT

Respect the markers provided by the affected utilities. They are your guide for the duration of your project.

5

DIG CAREFULLY

If you can't avoid digging near the markers (within 18-24 inches on all sides) consider moving your projects.
